Laying of the Foundation Stone of St. Alban's and St Patrick's Girls  
Schools Blackburn.

THE FOUNDATION STONE OF THE ABOVE Schools will be laid on  
WHIT-MONDAY, June 9<sup>th</sup> 1862 by the Very Rev. Canon IRVING,  
assisted by several clergy, men who have promised to be present on  
the occasion.

A GRAND PROCESSION of the Catholic School Children, Guilds,  
Brothers, and different Societies, Etc., will form in St. Alban's Square  
at 8.30 a.m. and the Procession will move at Nine o'clock, and, after  
proceeding through the principal streets of the town, will return to  
the site adjoining the Chapel.

The Stone will be laid at Eleven o'clock, after which a Collection will  
be made. Select pieces of music will be performed during the  
ceremony.

In the Evening a CONCERT and BALL will be held in the CATHOLIC  
HALL.
